All items of the Luckley uniform are also available to purchase from the Uniform Shop, based at the School. Personal appointments with the Uniform Coordinator are made for each new pupil.

Skirt uniform

Blazer
Tartan skirt (just above the knee)
Navy jumper or cardigan
White blouse
Navy knee length socks or tights (usually worn in the winter)
*White ankle socks (usually worn in the summer)
**Black shoes (ideally leather)

Trouser uniform

Blazer
Grey/charcoal trousers
Tartan tie
Navy jumper or cardigan
White shirt
*Grey or black socks
**Black shoes (ideally leather)

Anyone choosing to wear a trouser uniform must wear a tie with their shirt. If choosing a skirt uniform then no tie needs to be worn.

*Trainer socks are not permitted. **Black trainers or canvas style shoes are not permitted. Flat ballet style shoes are fine as long as they have a sole.

Sixth Form

Sixth Form students need to look very smart and business-like, with them often taking tours for visitors and prospective parents. For this reason, we request they be dressed in smart office wear.

- Suit (trouser or skirt with a blazer) - plain black, grey or blue
- Shirt – any colour, plain, with sleeves or Blouse – any colour, plain with sleeves
- Tie - any colour worn with a shirt
- Shoes or boots - black or brown

For formal occasions such as Open Morning and Prize Giving, Sixth Form should wear academic dress (black and white).

General Appearance (Year 7 to 11)

- Long hair must be worn off the face and collar, tied back in a style that does not interfere with clear vision or safety requirements.
- Hair must not be coloured and make-up must not be worn.
- Girls' skirts must be on, or no more than 5cms above, the knee.
- The blazer is compulsory throughout the year.
- Pupils may wear a wrist watch, a discreet plain gold/silver cross (or other religious symbol) and chain and one pair of simple studs, one in each pierced earlobe. Other items will be confiscated for at least one week.

General appearance Sixth Form

- Jewellery and make up should be discreet.
- Acrylics and nail varnish are acceptable as long as it doesn't impact on learning
- No visible tattoos
- All piercings should be well presented
- Nose piercings should either be a transparent or small stud when in school
- Hairstyles should not be extreme in style or colour but always look smart, tidy and brushed
