All items of the Luckley uniform are also available to purchase from the Uniform Shop, based at the School. Personal appointments with the Uniform Coordinator are made for each new pupil.

### **Skirt uniform**

Blazer  
Tartan skirt (just above the knee)  
Navy jumper or cardigan  
White blouse  
Navy knee length socks or tights  
White ankle socks  
\*Black shoes (ideally leather)

### **Trouser uniform**

Blazer  
Grey trousers  
Tartan tie  
Navy jumper or cardigan  
White shirt (top button to be done up)  
Grey or black socks  
\*Black shoes (ideally leather)

\* Flat, ballet-style shoes are acceptable if they have a solid sole. Canvas shoes or trainers are not permitted, as they are not smart. Shoes should also be low-heeled. Boots are also not permitted.

### **General Appearance**

- Blazers are always worn.
- Shirts must remain tucked in throughout the school day.
- Long hair (touching the shoulders or below) must be worn off the face and tied back in a style that does not interfere with clear vision or safety requirements.
- Hair should be natural in colour not extreme in colour.
- All hair styles, including colour, should be suitable for school and will be at the discretion of the Head as to whether a style/colour is permitted.
- Year 10 – 11 only are permitted to wear natural looking make up and see through or pastel pink/beige nail varnish.
- Acrylic nails are not permitted as they hinder learning in terms of writing and taking part in practically based sessions such as science experiments and sporting activities.
- The length of skirt should be just above the knee.
- A discrete chain is permitted – other items of jewellery such as rings and bracelets are not allowed.
- One pair of simple studs, one in each ear may be worn in each pierced earlobe. No cartilage or nose piercings are allowed.
- Pupils who have more than one piercing will be expected to either take out any additional ones until they're left with a single pair or if newly pierced, to be covered up with tape.
