OVERVIEW

We are looking to recruit a part-time Language Assistant to assist with the teaching of German in the Modern Foreign Languages Department.

Working solely with students in Years 10 to 13, the German Language Assistant will help students with their preparation for the oral component of public examinations.

The teaching commitment will involve approximately 4 hours a week. These hours are subject to fluctuation according to uptake at both GCSE and A level.

The main responsibilities of the post are to:

- Conduct conversation sessions with students, individually or in small groups, according to the instructions of the class teacher.
- Be aware of the requirements of the oral exams at both GCSE and A level, and be able to prepare students for these requirements with the support of the class teacher.
- Be a fluent German speaker.
