

Sixth Form Uniform



Sixth Form students need to look very smart and business-like, with them often taking tours for visitors and prospective parents. For this reason, we request they be dressed in smart office wear. Students must bring a jacket /blazer to school each day, but this need not be worn throughout the day. A jacket/blazer should always be worn to assembly or when taking tours and meeting guests. Skirts or dresses should be no shorter than just above the knee. Very tight-fitting attire is not permitted. Trousers should be full length. Shorts are not permitted unless for sports.

All students should have:

- Suit, trouser, skirt or dress - black, dark grey or navy for formal wear.
- Smart office trousers, skirt or dress – may be worn daily and for non-formal occasions
- Shirt or Blouse - any colour suitable for the office place. Plain, or with a simple pattern e.g. pinstripe with short or long sleeves
- Cardigan or Jumper - any colour suitable for the office place. Plain, or with a simple pattern
- Tie - any colour worn with a shirt (Tie only needs to be worn for formal occasions)
- Shoes or boots - black or brown

For formal occasions such as Open Morning and Prize Giving, Sixth Form should wear formal dress.

By way of keeping things simple, many students choose to purchase a black suit suitable for formal dress and wear different shirts, blouses or tie as needed.

- Jewellery and make up should be discreet.
- Acrylics and nail varnish are acceptable if it doesn't impact on learning.
- No visible tattoos.
- Ear piercings should be well presented and suitable for the office.
- Any other piercings should not be visible or a transparent stud when in school.
- Hairstyles should not be extreme in style or colour but always look smart, tidy and brushed.
